

Street Banners Construction Sheet

Instructions below are intended for the Street Banners with 2 Mounting Bracket Sets (examples are pictured below).







IMPORTANT! WALL MOUNTED

Refer to the directions that correspond with your Street Banner, but substitute Steel Bands (G) with screws. This is achieved by inserting screws into the provided screw holes on brackets.



1. Put end cap (F) in Aluminum tube (D) and insert opposite end into the Mounting bracket (C). Use the Allen wrench (B) to tighten the Hex screw (already in place in the mounting bracket). Twist the Eyelet screw (E) to secure tube into place.





2. Determine the height the top Mounting bracket (C) will be attached and wrap the stainless Steel band (G) around the pole. Bring the end of the Steel band (G) under the screw locking-mechanism. The screw must be in the up position.



3. Place the Mounting bracket (C) between the Steel band (G) and the pole. Pull the Steel band (G) tight and secure the screw locking-mechanism by pushing down. Repeat Steps 2 and 3 for the second Steel band (G) on the top Mounting Bracket (C).



4. Mount the print sliding the street banner onto Aluminum tube (D) with the grommet on the inside of the pole.




5. Repeat steps 1-4 to mount the bottom street banner Aluminum tube (D).




6. Secure the banner by attaching a Zip tie (A) through the Eyelet screw (E) and grommet located on the banner at the top and bottom Aluminum tubes (D).

Instructions below are intended for the Street Banners with 1 Mounting Bracket Set and 1 Eyelet Bracket Set (examples are pictured below).







1. Refer to page 1 and complete steps 1-4 to assemble the Mounting Bracket (C) and the print.




2. Determine the location of the bottom of the banner. Wrap the Steel band (G) through the Eyelet bracket (H) and adjust around the pole. Pull the Steel band (G) tight and secure the screw locking-mechanism by pushing down.




3. Secure the banner by attaching a Zip tie (A) through the Eyelet screw (E) and grommet located on the banner at the top and bottom.

Instructions below are intended for the Street Banners with 4 Eyelet Bracket Sets (example pictured below).







2. Pull the polyester cord through the grommet on the banner and secure through the Eyelet bracket (H). Repeat for all 4 grommets and Eyelet Bracket Sets.
