## **Installation Instructions:**

- 1. Handle with care. Do not drag the panels lift to avoid scratching.
- 2. Using a stud finder, locate and mark the studs for attaching panels to wall.



- 3. Create a level line at the desired height for the top of the panels.
- 4. Cut panels with a circular saw, or table saw. To minimize chip-out, the saw blade should enter the grooved side of the panel and exit the back.
- 5. If stacking, install the bottom panels first. Panels come with a half groove on the top and bottom for stacking purposes.
- 6. Screw the fasteners through the grooves into the stud wall.
- 7. It is recommended to use furring strips when attaching to cement walls.
- 8. Use 11/2" screws directly onto studs 2" screws if going through drywall.
- 9. Fasten screws into every other groove, each stud 16" on center studs are recommended.
- e metal insert to anchor it ler head to fit through the
- 10. For panels with metal inserts, pre-drill and screw through the back of the metal insert to anchor it with the panel to the stud. It is recommend to use a screw with a smaller head to fit through the opening in the insert (#6 panhead screw).
- 11. Clean with a soft cloth and water. Do not use harsh abrasive cleansers. **GET ORGANIZED!**
